Awarded in the Fields of: Media, Broadcasting and Public Speaking

Number of Awards: Varies from year to year

Scholarship Award: US\$500-\$1,000 check

Application Deadline: Check website for date

Applications sent by mail must be postmarked no later than: Check Website for date

Candidate Selection Criteria:

- Graduating High School senior in the U.S. or graduating secondary school student in the Caribbean interested in Broadcast or Media-related studies.
- Overall grade point average of at least 2.5 or C+ student.
- Student who is a national of the United States or any Caribbean country.
- Student participation in extracurricular activities, community work / social service, school, church, volunteer or work experience.

Application Process:

Please submit the following:

1. Fully completed application form;
2. A recent photo (head shot – in .jpg format if emailed);
3. A copy of your birth certificate, national ID card or ID page of passport;
4. A short typed 400 word essay telling us something compelling about yourself we might not learn from your application;
5. Copy of your official high School / Secondary School transcript (with official seal);
6. Two letters of recommendation from (e.g. pastor, high school counselor, teacher, coach or employer).
